Kimberly qualified for the second position in our stepladder finals by rolling a 642 handicap series in the semifinals. She then defeated Joey Jocson by a score of 233-200 to advance to the title match against top seeded Enrique Chavez. Kimberly started slowly in the championship match by opening in the first two frames to fall behind by 19 pins. But open

frames by Enrique in the 3rd and 6th frames and a turkey by Kimberly in frames 4, 5, and 6 turned the match around and by the 7th frame Kimberly had opened up a 36 pin lead. Enrique made a strong bid in the last 3 frames but Kimberly was up to the challenge and held on for the final victory by a score of 204-177.

She also thanked Hawthorn Lanes for hosting the ABT and Eric Anderson for talking her into joining. Kimberly didn't have any immediate plans for the \$900.00 she won other than to enjoy it. Kimberly said she really enjoys bowling the ABT and that lane conditions this week were absolutely gorgeous. Her ambition is to eventually be good enough to compete on the Ladies Pro Tour. The ABT should go a long way in helping her to realize that ambition.
