***** CZYZNIK WINS FIRST TITLE AT LAKESIDE *****

Don Czyznik won his first ABT title by defeating Rick Hara 238 to 206 at Lakeside Lanes in Mundelein. Rick Wunder and John Kolodziej opened the stepladder with Rick coming away a winner 238-211. Rick then moved past Bill Choporis 237-224 before falling to Don Czyznik 270-197. That moved Don into the championship match versus top-seeded Rick Hara. Don opened the match leaving a 4-6-10 split and covering two all but wiping out the small handicap advantage he held over Rick. However Don rode a string of strikes from the 3rd through the 7th giving him a 28-pin lead through 7 frames. Rick hung in the entire match, but faltered in the 10th, failing to convert the 3-10. Don went on to win the match 238-206.

Champion's Profile: Don Czyznik is 54 years old and is a self employed consultant. He is married to Lenore and they have 4 children, Kyle, Andrea, Colleen, and Justine. Don has been bowling 35 years and bowls league at Fair Haven in Mundelein. His high game is 300 and he has an 826 series to his credit. He was throwing The Big One from Ebonite, which was drilled by Anthony Weidenfeller at Fair Haven. When asked who has helped him with his game he replied "the people at Fair Haven, you know who you are!" Don wanted to thank John Wing, proprietor at Lakeside Lanes, the ABT spectators, and all of his friends at Fair Haven. Don plans to use his winnings to pay for his trip to the USBC Nationals.
